THE LORD'S KITCHEN

Here are a few simple rules that would be nice to follow.

1. Trash must be taken out after each event, no matter how small amount.  
(Do Not leave the trash for the bugs.)
2. All trash must be put in a black trash bag or the collectors will not take it.
3. All dishes & pans should be washed and put away.
4. The counter tops should be cleaned and wiped dry.
5. Any tea-towels used should be taken home, washed and returned.
6. Take all unused food home. Do Not leave it in the refrigerator or freeze.  
(The refrigerator and the freeze will be cleaned on regular bases,  
all unmarked food will be thrown away.)
7. Children & Adults.....Please do not sit on the tables.
8. Be sure the lights are turned off.
9. Check thermostat... (Up in summer and down in the winter.)
10. Be sure the church is locked when you leave.

Remember this is God's House and  
He wants us to share His good/clean blessings with one another.
